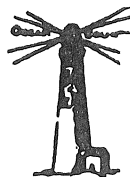

Dear Parents and Staff:


In compliance with the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), an inspection of all school buildings was done to identify any possible asbestos containing building materials. The inspection results and subsequent management plans have been on file in each building since the implementation date of July 1989.

The EPA further requires schools to perform re-inspections of asbestos containing building materials in schools every three years. During the summer of 2010, accredited asbestos inspectors performed these required re-inspections. An accredited management planner reviewed the results and recommended response actions to be taken to safely manage any asbestos material identified in the building.

The results of the re-inspections and recommended response actions are contained in the management plan, are on file in the schools main office, and can be reviewed anytime during normal school hours.
